

**The recent records of *Purpuricenus kaehleri* (Linnaeus, 1758) and *Cerambyx cerdo* Linnaeus, 1758 (Coleoptera: Cerambycidae) in Zakarpattia, Ukraine.-** *Purpuricenus kaehleri* (Linnaeus, 1758) and *Cerambyx cerdo* Linnaeus, 1758 are two of the rarest species of Cerambycidae in Ukraine. They both are included to the Red data book of Ukraine. While *C. cerdo* is wide distributed throughout plain and mountains oak forests, the areal of *P. kaehleri* occupies forest and steppe zone of East Pannonia Plain. Fasulaty (1955) noticed *P. kaehleri* only in surroundings of the city of Uzhgorod. Recently, it has recorded 24.VI.2012 near village Okli-Ged (Vynohradiv dstr.) by Yuriy Geryak. Accordingly to Fasulaty (1955) *C. cerdo* is known from several localities in Zakarpattia such as surroundings of Uzhgorod, Mukacheve, Vynohradiv, Maly Berezny, and Tyachiv. He noticed that *C. cerdo* was common everywhere in old oak forests. Today, it has recorded at the Uzhanskiy National Park 21.IX.2012 in surroundings of town Velykiy Berezny by N. Koval.-**Andrew M.
